## **MPO RESOLUTION 2019-9**

RE:	AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2019-2022 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Act of 1962, as amended, and the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provide for an urban transportation planning process; and
WHEREAS	the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act currently authorizes funding to improve our nation's transportation system for highways, highway safety, public transit, alternative non-motorized forms of transportation, and freight; and
WHEREAS	the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act and its predecessors, require a Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) as well as a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and
WHEREAS	the Region 1 Planning Council is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Rockford Urban and Metropolitan Area, and the MPO Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process: and
WHEREAS	the MPO Policy Committee has adopted the August 23, 2018 version of the Fiscal Year 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and;
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have approved the FY 2019-2022 MPO TIP; and
WHEREAS	the City of Rockford, the Winnebago County Highway Department, the Rockford Mass Transit District (RMTD), and the Illinois Department of Transportation have requested an amendment to the TIP for the purpose of updating the funding totals and details of existing TIP projects as well as adding new projects; and
WHEREAS	additional projects being amended into the adopted and approved version of the FY 2019-2022 TIP will not affect or impact the existing projects already listed in the FY 2019-2022 MPO TIP;
WHEREAS	the MPO Technical Committee has recommended the adoption of the TIP amendment by the MPO Policy
