\$2 Million Available for Grassroots Mental Health Initiatives

ROCKFORD, IL — The Winnebago County Community Mental Health Board (WCCMHB) is seeking proposals for a new funding opportunity aimed to encourage innovative mental health and substance use programming This Grassroots Funding intends to provide a total \$2 million for mental health and substance use programming over the next two years to small, community-based organizations.

For Grassroots Funding, the Board will accept proposals from small, community-based nonprofits seeking to enact meaningful and innovative services to the communities in Winnebago County they serve. Funding will be prioritized to organizations with a \$1 million operating budget or less. Awarded organizations cannot be current awardees of WCCMHB Core Funding, and must either be geographically aligned to the community they serve or utilize innovative local solutions to solve local mental health or substance use problems.

"The establishment of a Grassroots funding opportunity allows the Board to support small nonprofits while simultaneously addressing the mental health or substance use needs of Winnebago County." Board President Mary Ann Abate says. "We recognize that smaller nonprofits are uniquely positioned to address certain local mental health and substance use issues."

ABOUT WCCMHB – The purpose of the Winnebago County Community Mental Health Board (WCCMHB) is a board of appointed community leaders and public officials dedicated to investing and supporting mental health and substance use services for adults and children in Winnebago County. WCCMHB receives funding through a half-cent sales tax which was approved by Winnebago County residents in March 2020. This sales tax generates approximately \$18 million annually for mental health and substance use services across the county. WCCMHB

positively impacts the Winnebago County community by increasing access to local services by providing support and funding to organizations, non-profits, and government agencies that offer mental health and substance use services. This allows Winnebago County residents to live and recover in the community.

ABOUT RPC – Region 1 Planning Council is a special-purpose, regional government agency providing cross-jurisdictional, government-to-government collaborative planning for Northern Illinois.
