3. Public Comment

4. Approval of May 15, 2025 Board Meeting Minutes

5. CEDS Update – Isaac Guerrero

Mr. Guerrero gave an overview of the CEDS and its purpose in providing a five-year plan for regional economic development. He encouraged everyone to ensure a member of their staff attends R1's regular CEDS Steering Committee meetings. Being a part of those meetings will give jurisdictions access to funding for projects.

6. Vote on RESOLUTION 2025-17 Adoption of 2026-2030 CEDS

Motion by City of Rockford, seconded by Rockford Mass Transit District, to approve RESOLUTION 2025-17.

Motion approved unanimously by voice vote.

7. Action Item: Vote to add nominees to Regional Data Advisory Committee (Park District RVC)

<u>Motion</u> by City of Rockford, seconded by Greater Rockford Chamber of Commerce, to <u>approve</u> the Action Item. Motion <u>approved</u> unanimously by voice vote.

8. Transportation Update – Tim Verbeke

Mr. Verbeke highlighted several of the Planning team's 41 projects in progress. Plans featured include the Housing Coordination plan, CAP engagement, Livable Communities Initiative, Main Street Corridor and Rockford Parks Traffic Study, ADA self-evaluation and Transition Plan, and GRIP.

9. Community Development Update – Eric Setter

Mr. Setter gave results of the recent Land Bank sale and projects planned on former school sites. His team is seeking recommendations for properties that could receive US EPA Brownfield Grant environmental assessments. Jimmy Westenberg, Housing Counselor, spoke on R1's new housing counseling services, which began in August. R1 is a HUD-approved housing agency and is now providing services in Winnebago, Boone, and Stephenson counties. He has been reaching out to area organizations to build a referral network and sees many opportunities for future expansion.

10. Executive Director's Report and FY25 Financial Results

Mr. Dunn invited Martesha Brown, Community Advisory Forum Chair, to speak on the positive momentum that group is making in encouraging community-wide feedback and engagement. Mr. Dunn gave a high-level explanation of where each team's progress for 2025. He spoke on COG membership, COG engagement on biometric privacy/data center policy, the CEDS, Land Bank sales site, and passenger rail. Mr. Dunn announced that the region has been appointed as a cohort in piloting AI functionalities for transportation planning, and transportation and AI opportunities for transportation planning, and that R1 was named an APEX Accelerator Regional Intermediary.

Everyone is encouraged to attend the R1 Open House on September 25 from 3-5.

Mr. Dunn reported that financials for FY25 are overall positive and R1 ended the year in the black.

Mayor McNamara proposed that members of this group and other key stakeholders meet with IDOT to discuss the current status of passenger rail. Mr. Dunn will look into scheduling that meeting.
