Livable Communities Initiative Now Accepting Applications for Neighborhood Revitalization Planning

ROCKFORD, IL – Not distressed, but not affluent. Rockford's middle neighborhoods need attention too. Rockford's Livable Communities Initiative (LCI) will give them the boost they need to flourish.

Region 1 Planning Council (R1) is now accepting applications for the second round of LCI. Applications will be accepted through **August 4, 2025**, with the selected neighborhood announced on November 13, 2025. Through this program, R1 will assist eligible neighborhoods in designing a plan to improve livability for residents. Once a neighborhood revitalization plan is complete, awardees will be eligible for implementation funding.

Examples of livability enhancements through LCI may include improved traffic safety measures, upgraded street lighting and signage, the creation of shared public spaces, and the addition of painted crosswalks and other roadway markings to enhance pedestrian safety. By helping to stabilize and invigorate these communities, R1 aims to promote community well-being, inclusivity, and long-term economic sustainability.

The Keith Creek Neighborhood was the recipient of the first round of LCI assistance. R1 is currently hosting public meetings to determine residents' needs and priorities for their implementation plan.
