#### 5. **Agency Reports**

#### **Livable Communities Initiative (LCI) Prsentations**

Marc Hooks described the Livable Communities Initiative (LCI) as combining R1's expertise along with neighborhood input to enhance communities and drive overall improvement. Today, the CAF heard proposals from neighborhoods and was instructed to fill out a scoring rubric. The group will then rank presentations and provide a final recommendation.

#### a. Northwest Neighbors

#### b. Keith Creek

Dennis Rich, 30+ year resident of Keith Creek, presented on the neighborhood's proposal for LCI funding. The proposal aims to address flooding in the neighborhood. Questions followed.

#### c. South East Belvidere

Dan Snow, former Belvidere Alderman, presented on the neighborhood's proposal for LCI funding. The proposal plans to construct a curb, gutter, and sidewalk, as the existence and quality is currently inconsistent. Questions followed.

#### d. Signal Hill

Dave Schultz, Co-President of Signal Hill Neighborhood Association, presented on the neighborhood's proposal for LCI funding. The proposal aims to transfer ownership of their park to the Rockford Park District for maintenance and upgrades. Questions followed.

#### e. Ranking LCI Applications

Members had time to complete the rubrics and rank the presentations. The highest-ranked proposal will receive technical assistance from R1 to develop a sub-area planning study, laying the groundwork for future implementation.
