
## Overview of Economic Indicators Ourmap

- iii. To communicate to residents and other partners how the economic development efforts and investment are benefitting all areas of the City.





#### **Rockford Customers by Zip Code**






# **Year to Date Hotel Occupancy**




### **Year-to-Date Hotel Room Demand**
