5. Presentation: 2024 Financial Audit

Alison Kmen, Lauterbach & Amen, LLP

Ms. Kmen completed R1's 2024 audit for Lauterbach & Amen. Overall, the report is positive, with few recommendations that are being addressed.

6. Vote on RESOLUTION 2025-06 Approval of FY24 Audit

<u>Motion</u> by Village of Cherry Valley, seconded by City of Belvidere, to <u>approve</u> the Resolution. Motion <u>approved</u> unanimously by voice vote.

7. Presentation: Economic Development Outlook and EDA Reauthorization

Tom Baron, Illinois and Wisconsin EDA Representative

Mr. Baron, R1's Economic Development Administration representative, gave an update on the EDA.

- EDA Reauthorization: Federal agencies periodically undergo this process to update their mission and make adjustments. Reauthorization was approved by Congress in December 2024. There are several impacts to Economic Development Districts: additional metrics to determine grant eligibility, a new Office of Disaster Recovery to provide assistance for long-term economic recovery after a disaster, an increase to the baseline grant rate, and EDA funding now available to small communities. The EDA is in the process of updating documents to reflect these changes.
- 2. <u>Disaster declaration:</u> Winnebago County received a disaster declaration in September 2024, making it eligible for supplemental EDA funding.

The board was encouraged to reach out to R1 with any economic development projects to begin developing project plans and advise on grant opportunities. There were no questions.

11. Vote on RESOLUTION 2025-09 Approve Insurance Provider

12. Executive Director's Report and Quarter 3 Financial Results

Mr. Dunn pointed out that R1 staff is doing a great job, especially in the face of significant federal cuts. The organization is looking to end fiscal year in the black for the fourth year in a row. Mr. Dunn highlighted the MPO's Safe Streets grant as a recent accomplishment for the MPO, as R1 was one of first MPOs to complete this study and the only one to complete in-house. The City of Rockford will be conducting a bike/pedestrian study based on the results of the Safe Streets report.

13. Vote on RESOLUTION 2025-10 Adopt FY26 Budget

14. Action Item: Approve Nominations for Regional Data Advisory Committee – Jason Holcomb

Mr. Holcomb explained the purpose of a newly formed Data Advisory Committee, which is to oversee data management activity and needs evaluations for the region. R1 solicited committee member nominations from the Board and R1 staff, to be approved for a two-year term.

Motion by City of Rockford, seconded by Boone County, to approve the Action Item.

Motion **approved** unanimously by voice vote.

15. Vote on RESOLUTION 2025-11 Adoption of the CAP

Clara Romeo and Lauren Kleve gave an overview of the region's first Climate Action Plan (CAP). The CAP outlines plans for climate change mitigation and adaptation over the next 25 years. The plan was developed by R1 staff and included a broad range of regional stakeholders during the development process. Ms. Kleve gave an overview of specific findings and recommendations.

Regional agencies are responsible for implementing the recommendations, with support from R1. Any agencies who are not listed as a responsible party for any of the action items and would like to be are asked to contact R1 to be added.
