MPO RESOLUTION 2020-01

RE:	AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2020-2023 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Act of 1962, as amended, and the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provide for an urban transportation planning process; and
WHEREAS	the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act currently authorizes funding to improve our nation's transportation system for highways, highway safety, public transit, alternative non-motorized forms of transportation, and freight; and
WHEREAS	the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act and its predecessors, require a Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) as well as a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and
WHEREAS	the Region 1 Planning Council is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Rockford Urban and Metropolitan Area, and the MPO Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process: and
WHEREAS	the MPO Policy Committee has adopted the August 29, 2019 version of the Fiscal Year 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and;
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have approved the FY 2020-2023 MPO TIP; and
WHEREAS	the Illinois Department of Transportation, the City of Rockford, and the Rockford Mass Transit District have requested an amendment to the TIP for the purpose of updating the funding totals and details of existing TIP projects as well as adding new projects; and
WHEREAS	additional projects being amended into the adopted and approved version of the FY 2020-2023 TIP will not affect or impact the existing projects already listed in the FY 2020-2023 MPO TIP;
WHEREAS	the MPO Technical Committee has recommended the adoption of the TIP amendment by the MPO Policy Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The MPO Policy Committee hereby amends the FY 2020-2023 MPO Transportation Improvement Program to include the changes listed in Attachment A.
