Public Comment Period: Complete Streets Design Standards

ABOUT THE STANDARDS – The Rockford Region Complete Street Design Standards provides a framework to guide local municipalities, counties, partner agencies, and private organizations in designing, constructing, and maintaining Complete Streets. These guidelines describe and illustrate parameters as well as providing specific information related to design in order to assist the region in planning for future investments.

Complete streets are not a one size fits all approach and encourage roadways to be designed and operated in order to provide safe and accessible travel for all users regardless of age or ability. Complete streets aim to balance the needs of motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users, emergency responders, and movement of goods.
