MPO RESOLUTION 2024-03

RE: Adoption of the Complete Streets Policy

WHEREAS the Region 1 Planning Council (R1) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the

Rockford Metropolitan Area, and the MPO Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to

direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process; and

WHEREAS the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) authorizes the development and adoption of

Complete Street Policies in order to improve our nation's transportation system for highways,

highway safety, public transit, alternative non-motorized forms of transportation; and

WHEREAS the Region 1 Planning Council is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Rockford

Urban and Metropolitan Area, and the MPO Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to

direct and administer the continuation of Complete Street Policies and Standards; and

WHEREAS the purpose of the policy is to ensure that streets are designed and operated to enable safe use

for all users including people of all ages and abilities regardless if they are motorists, pedestrian,

bicyclists or public transportation users.

WHEREAS the MPO Technical Committee has reviewed MPO Resolution 2024-03 along with the Complete

Street Policy provided in "Attachment A" and has recommended that the Complete Streets Policy

for the Rockford Region be adopted by the MPO Policy Committee; and

WHEREAS MPO encourages its partner agencies to also adopt the Complete Streets Policy for the Rockford

Region and to incorporate the policy in future development plans within the region; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

the MPO Policy Committee hereby adopts the "Complete Streets Policy for the Rockford Region"
