MPO RESOLUTION 2022-04

RE:	AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2022-2025 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Act of 1962, as amended, and the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provide for an urban transportation planning process; and
WHEREAS	the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act currently authorizes funding to improve our nation's transportation system for highways, highway safety, public transit, alternative non-motorized forms of transportation, and freight; and
WHEREAS	the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act and its predecessors, require a Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) as well as a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and
WHEREAS	the Region 1 Planning Council is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Rockford Urban and Metropolitan Area, and the MPO Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process: and
WHEREAS	the MPO Policy Committee has adopted the August 27, 2021 version of the Fiscal Year 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and;
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have approved the FY 2022-2025 MPO TIP; and
WHEREAS	Illinois Department of Transportation requested a project cost update and the inclusion of a new Illustrative project, the City of Rockford has requested the inclusion of an additional project, and RMTD requested the inclusion of three additional projects; and
WHEREAS	the projects being amended in the adopted and approved version of the FY 2022-2025 TIP will not affect or impact the other projects listed in the FY 2022-2025 MPO TIP; and
WHEREAS	the MPO Technical Committee has recommended the adoption of the TIP amendment by the MPO Policy Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The MPO Policy Committee hereby amends the FY 2022-2025 MPO Transportation Improvement Program to include the projects listed in "Attachment A".
