
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About

An integral part of Rockford Mass Transit District's (RMTD) Comprehensive Mobility Analysis, the General Transit Survey provided an anonymous outlet for individuals to give feedback on multiple aspects of public transportation services within the Rockford region. The survey was open from November 19th, 2018 until January 31st, 2019, and was directed towards anyone who lives or works within the two county region.

Once opened, the survey was distributed through both RMTD's and the Region 1 Planning Council's (R1PC) local stakeholder email lists, respective social media accounts, and links on their websites. Paper copies of the survey were made available at RMTD's Downtown Transfer Center and East Side Transfer Center, and were supplied to any stakeholder upon request. In response to a local request, Spanish translated versions of the survey were made available at each organization's website, and paper copies were made available at both of RMTD's facilities and the Boone County Health Department. Paper versions of the surveys were also provided at all three of RMTD's Rider Forums.


Upon closing, 407 survey responses were collected. This includes 349 fully completed surveys and 58 partially completed surveys. This report provides a basic overview of responses to each question. Any question that did not receive an answer was categorized as No Answer, or N/A. Any comments associated with an answer have been provided in the Appendix.






2. How often do you ride the bus?




3. Which bus routes do you ride?




4. If necessary, where do you transfer buses?



5. How close do you live to a bus route?






6. Have you ever used public transportation in places outside of the Rockford Region?






8. For which of the following purposes do you use public transportation?



10. What keeps you from using public transportation more often?




11. How would you rate public transportation services within the Rockford Region?










14. How important do you think it is for the Rockford Region to support and fund public transportation?




20. How many operating vehicles do you have in your household?






21. What is your age group?



Increasing the mode share of transit riders, which requires a region-wide strategic plan with a number of objectives including 1) a reduction in the amount of single-occupancy vehicle trips and 2) how to make transit more convenient and connected for choice riders. Census data show auto as the mode choice for approx. 97% of commuters, with nearly 90% of those in single-occupancy vehicles. This is unacceptable and is simply not becoming of an urban area.

A18. Are there any additional comments or suggestions you would like to make to improve public transportation in the Rockford Region?

Public transportation should be a bigger priority in an area like Rockford where many residents are lower income and in need of reliable public transportation, but it is not currently a viable option for many people since the length of time it would take to get around the city varies so greatly and the service is not consistently offered.

Run some busses on holidays

Increase efficiency of routes by prioritizing stops with the most traffic

Boone and Winnebago Counties need to have a referendum on the ballot in the next election with the goal of forming a local Regional Transportation Authority so there can be a dedicated source of funding for RMTD and a potential commuter rail service to Chicago. This would allow for increased frequencies and routes for RMTD bus service as well as making a commuter rail service from Rockford to Chicago possible.

Given budget constraints RMTD does a great job servicing the community.

Higher Speed with last mile connectivity, Safety, Security and Reliability should be the focus. Crosswalk/Sidewalks/Lighting should be improved.

Public transportation is horrible in Rockford.

Mayor McNamara, The RMTD is as vital a service as The Police or The Fire Department. They do not receive the same consideration as The Police or The Fire Department. Please make it priority to include The RMTD in your plans to make Rockford a World Class City by 2025 with the help of Transform Rockford.

What is the feasibility/will for identifying select routes for BRT testing? Features such as signal prioritization and dedicated lanes can improve service efficiency.

Individuals in really big electronic wheelchairs, and very overweight individuals take up too much space and take too long to get on and off the normal buses. Some of us have places to be at certain times like work. I've almost been late to work four times because of wheel chairs

Add more steps to the SMTD service around Rockford

Smaller bus, when I see buses there are few people on it. The region needs busing. Phase out the bigger bus, this possibly could save on fuel, maintenance etc...

Think boldly!

Bus use is for those who are desperate, without better alternatives, and those who have unlimited time on their hands and are on a lark, or being experiential. I tried to get my kids to take the bus when they were teens and they refused. My daughter was terrified of her percepted marginal-types of riders, which is clearly ridiculous, and my son would rather ride his bike and control his time better. We live two blocks from a bus stop. I took the bus from Brooke Road and Kishwaukee Street to Rock Valley College for years when the only bus ran 8am arrival and 5pm departure so I know public transportation is critical to all facets of our city. I say go big or go home. Offer free trolleys throughout downtown, Midtown, Museum district and South Main to Colman complex. Just jump on anywhere with a stop at a large parking deck so you can leave your car without using street parking. Chicago does it and I can go to the Art Institute and later take the trolley to Navy Pier...for free. Great tourist attraction. It shouldn't take an hour to get from one side town to the other. Think out of the box! Solar buses. Kids ride school buses all the time. Use that familiarity to grow a bus-riding base. Arghhh! You people need to hire me!

Just making sure we keep safety front of mind with everything. Safety for people riding public transportation and those around the area near public transit stops and routes.

Within the transit and on the buses if there could be tutorials playing of real RMTD bus routes and instances previewing how to ride a bus and utilize transfers. Even on the website if there was a real live tutorial that taught people how to catch each route and showed them beforehand what the experience looks like, I think it may alleviate a lot of anxiety that comes with learning how to ride the bus.

Please make night services more available, as well expand service, try to be a leader in infrastructure with our transit system, I am new to the area and like what you guys are doing!

Get technology involved so that people can be picked up faster and dropped off at their destination quicker. Especially during the winter months. Have an app where you can pay for services when you use the bus. Another option from cash. Great big buses carrying one or two people most of the day seems like a huge waste of money and pollutes the air.

Just need more frequent buses at the stops so people aren't waiting hours.

I understand crosswalks are not always convenient to bus stops.

Yes the friendliness of the bus drivers!

It goes places I do not go, from places I cannot reach. Useless to me, as is.

On high volume routes have a local and express. Express from outer transfer stations to the main transfer downtown. Not every hour but maybe three times a day?

There needs to be faster routes. My commute to work from central Rockford to the southeast side would be 2 hours.

Overall, better connections both north and south, so I can have more flexibility when it comes to hours at work.

Maybe swing by the theatre before dropping off final route at Lyford station.

Follow a system more like CTA, where routes go up and down main streets, rather than weaving in and out of neighborhoods.

I do enjoy the shuttles to downtown big events. It is so convenient to drive to a parking lot that is familiar. It is so hard to find parking in downtown areas. I never go downtown because of parking issues. All the drivers are so helpful. The Chicago drivers seem to hate anyone that asks them any question. ALL Rockford drivers have always been helpful and courteous to riders who are unfamiliar with buses and routes

You need to serve State Street from downtown to Lyford as a straight shot. Cutting off to the side roads takes away from a busy main artery where people need to get to places without walking miles. Hit the side roads with another route, it makes more sense than cutting off of a business district road. Straight shot, both directions!

Promote connectivity between low-income areas to large employment centers, and prioritize service based on demand

More Local Investment in RMTD!

Have but travel every half an hour instead of an hour

The graphs printed in this year book do not show major transfer points nor times.

I've never understood the hub and spoke system. Unless someone lives on the exact route they always need, the system requires them to travel downtown to get anywhere. Dubuque did a study where they tracked several hundred riders and non-riders to determine where people actually traveled, then redesigned their routes to better meet needs. It resulted in a significant increase in transit usage. While I could take the bus to the grocery store and some other places, the rarity of busses coming by means the timing has to be perfect or there's a long wait for the next bus. That makes the bus too inconvenient to use.

I appreciate you all taking the time to reach out and offer this survey to the community. This shows commitment. I have many ideas on how to improve public transit in this region and I also recognize the funding and logistical difficulties that go into the planning and implementation of this. I would like to be included on any public meetings or coalition meetings discussing this topic. I work in local public health and can be

Working with participants that must use the bus to get to work, it is difficult to get back and forth to UPS, Pinnacle and other airport shipping companies. It is very difficult on Sundays and the middle of the night shifts. There is also a need to get workers to Chrysler and the feeder companies in Belvidere.

I don't feel safe at all

Provide benches to sit at bus stops. Maybe have smaller buses running and twice as many for better times to catch and drop off.

Post Bus Route and Stops placard in each bus showing where it goes and where it stops.

Major revamp needs to happen with paratransit. Paratransit needs its own survey

Having more transfer points for bus routes, have buses meet at the same times for easy transferring, expand am and pm services-or make it a 24hour service, add shuttle buses during the day that get people to their farthest destinations faster, Westside-Eastside, and Northside-Southside. it would be nice if the City of Rockford would work with RMTD to improve neighborhood streets so that RMTD buses can add more neighborhood stops. Rockford is growing but it is still a smaller city, it's going on 2019 Rockford can have a full-coverage, full-service public transportation system if we want it bad enough.

My daughter has used the bus service in the past but as we live on the NE side by Edgebrook, it is a long walk to get to the bus stops. Although, I would totally like to see more bus opportunities to areas where people do not have cars, I think more could be added off of Alpine, Mulford and State. Need to run later at night for those working second and third shift and on the weekends for this same purpose. Why did you build on Bell School Road where the majority of people drive in that area, seems like quite the waste of tax payer's money, could have been better served by having a station around Alpine and State or Alpine and Harrison or at the Mall. There are many jobs in the Rockford area that go unfilled because potential employees do not have access to their own vehicle and must rely on bus service that doesn't meet their needs. Also, what is the deal with every bus needing to go downtown to make transfers? If you hadn't built the bus station way out on the East side where no one is using it for service around the city, you could have served the public much better.

I looked into taking the bus from my home in Roscoe and couldn't figure out a way to get from there to my work downtown that was timely. I thought it should have been simpler to find the route on the website

Make it more accessible. An app that is readily available and easy to use for scheduling is great. I live right next to a stop and have often wondered if I should take it to work, but I am unsure of times and where the bus goes!

Service and drivers are great, just more bus stops and buses should come more often than every hour

Bus cleanliness is another deterring factor. Many times it makes it hard to want to ride buses. There really needs to be more buses for existing routes like the City Loop and Alpine, which take a long time to complete

Put night buses as in the afternoon I use it often

I believe RMTD should have more routes, longer service on weekends with that includes regular schedule services on Sunday instead of night service and longer service instead of ending service in the afternoon.

Just making it more available to those who are in need but don't have it

Moved here from Peoria. Took public transportation to school, mall, and swimming facilities. Busses came all the time and when needed. Moved to Rockford and routes seem very limited for many needs.

All weather bus stops solar powered and with heat, walkways and sidewalks surrounding especially down busy roads where folks have to walk in the street because of snow and ice on walkways.

Serve a larger portion of the county.

Late night transit to make it safer for people working late to be able to affordably get across town.

I no longer take the bus. But when I did I was at a point when it was super important because it allowed me to find a job and be at that job. If we have the infrastructure in place to help people travel it will give more people the opportunity to find jobs or go to school of job training classes. It is an integral part in helping people who are poor become not poor. I now own 8 different businesses and it was the bus which helped me get my start. Feel free to contact me if you need any further help in regards to this or any other help needed to help more people escape poverty.

The city should work to improve punctual service. I've seen people waiting at bus stops well beyond the scheduled time and feel so sorry for them. Increased and improved transit services allow residents to access needed services, find and maintain employment and generally remain positively engaged in the community. Places that lack good transit services leave community members isolated which is a major factor for recidivism, poverty and disengagement.

RMTD is doing a very good job already. Keep up the good work.

If rail service comes to the area there should be good transportation connections to this.

there seems to be a lot of residential area with long walks to bus stops, to get from one side of town to another multiple transfers....

Would be nice to have high school kids be able to get to school on City Bus

All bus stops need to have enclosures and a bench.

The city is not that big. There should be bus access to all areas of the city

I work for a staffing agency. The buses do not have routes near our clients and if they do they don't match the shifts people are working. You need routes that allow people to have employment and make riding affordable.

The service needs to be practical. My commute, from the symbol to the clocktower, takes over 2 hours one way on RMTD. Not feasible

Give a desk job to drivers like and who can't stay on schedule and who make passengers arrive late and miss our connections

I would like buses to run just north and south and east and west. North/South buses would be Central, Pierpont, Main, North 2nd Street, Forest Hills Road, Alpine, Mulford, Perryville and Lyford. East/West would be State Street, Harrison, Montegue, Jefferson, Huffman, Riverside, Harlem. Newburg, Broadway, Charles. There's too much going in and out of shopping centers and side streets.

Shake up some of your employees. Get them to give service with a smile. No one likes a sour apple.

I am very happy with the existing service and happy you want me to take this survey. Thanks.

Teach drivers how to properly drive around cyclist.

The current bus fleet is TOO big in size. Recommend smaller buses as I see most of the time the buses are running empty or near empty.

We need passenger rail

Need the train stations to the Chicago in the Rockford Region.

The North Loop and South loop serve too great of an area to be efficient. If it was split into four routes or greater it'd be faster and more convenient for those who would like to take it. As of right now I can't afford to Uber and am dreading having to take public transportation because of how in-efficient it is

You should schedule route 24 at least every hour how is it possible that i have to wait so long to ride the bus i can't ride it whenever you want but whenever i need to. How is it possible that the route 24 is not available on the weekends is a poor service people need to go to places and i have to pay ridiculous money for uber or staying home is a terrible service. I also want to complain that the bus driver let in a crazy woman on the bus making passengers feel unsafe and uncomfortable. Also you need to update your schedule cause apparently google map doesn't get the memo that there are no buses on the weekends

Stop playing politics & pandering to freeloaders that clearly have no intention of contributing to taxes or bettering both public transportation as well as this area.

Be a little cleaner, transfer center inside and out, buses.

We have master's degrees and can't figure out your confusing route map. It's ridiculous. We take buses elsewhere and internationally and can't even use our hometown bus because of the poor tools provided. Plus, your public relations staff has been rude to us. Not happy at all with RMTD!

Possibly serve every town. Maybe schedule with residents that would like to use public transportation a time every day it'd be best available

In Boone County there is a lack of extended hours that bars individuals from going place to place. Additionally, there is a lack of knowledge in all of the transportation services offered in Boone County, who can use utilize them, routes, costs, etc.

YES, drivers that are not rude to the riders and who know how to come to a bus stop on time. And to not speed and slam on their brakes causing the riders to get hurt

I feel so strongly that the economy and the livability of Rockford would be dramatically improved if there was train service to Elgin (and it's connection to Chicago)

I'm new to Rockford coming from major city in California. The transit system here seems outdated and not user friendly for working individuals. This state doesn't really support pollution control as far as less cars on the road and better transit. If I could ride the bus more I would but it's such a hassle. The best thing is the bus system to the airports I'm not sure if you are a part of it but that's a great idea.

Make transfer stations safer and more room on buses

For at night riding. Have lights in bus stops and shelters.

Busses should run 24/7 people need to go to work at all times, I'm tired of my good employees having to leave early, maybe have push buttons at the bus stops so the driver knows of someone is there or not maybe turns light on, on outside of structure, have some sort of button for driver to turn light off At stop, will speed up routes, maybe have a express bus for the most popular routes that do not stop and wait, no set schedule, just do the route as many times as possible in the day with no waiting at transfer spots either they are ready or not. If you want more ideas you can call me

Run later on Saturday's and more routes on Sunday

More frequent buses operating 24/7/365 to ALL parts of your service region should be a HIGH priority-15 minutes is too long to wait for a bus at ANY time of day on EVERY day of the week.

Sell the need of busses and how they will help get our Westside students to jobs and school.

I really feel that the buses should run all night bc it's hard to find rides home from work if we get off work late or we if we get off work before buses run. We all need jobs!! And all night thru weekends bc like my job i mostly work weekends late at night.

Yes, adding trips to the Metra station (to access Chicago) in Harvard, IL and or McHenry, IL For example three-four trips per day 6am, 9am, noon and 4pm at least two to three days a week for example Wednesdays and Fridays or Tuesday and Saturdays. Advertising of this service to access Chicago should pay for itself.

State Street DIRECT east & west. No turn offs. Find another way to do the turn offs. You need to cover the ENTIRE stretch of State Street. Rockford

The system is currently not accessible -- Boone County does not get service after 5pm last time I checked. It is not accessible in the sense that in some places you need to walk over 1 mile to reach a bus in Boone County. It can't be used to visit City Market or the downtown for night life. If you needed to do something during business hours that would take a very short time, you could maybe use the bus from Boone County. As for getting around BC -- the central part of town is walkable and bikeable, and this is where the bus runs, so someone in my demographic -- which you failed to ask about in this survey, would not use it for anything where I can walk, ride or drive a car with little traffic and ample parking. Not a transit expert, but I am a market researcher with specialization in methodology -- survey fails to ask a lot of things and poor design will yield poor results in this attempt to gather information -- though I understand the limitations of public funds ---data is a great tool if you have it and can trust it. What is being done with this survey right now is qualitative in the dark. You know nothing about the people responding and unless you are tagging IPs and certain that it's not more than one person using the same IP, this survey can be taken by the same person multiple times. -- there is no quality control on this -- so don't report this data or use it to guide business decisions -- it is just to "get an idea" As a market researcher -- this is brief guide on how to do the consumer research right -- 1) Qualitative -- recruit a "representative sample" of riders and nonriders to discuss why they do and don't ride -- what they like, what they don't, what they wish could be different or could change if they could. Gather all other data and information known about ridership -- from actual rider data, other research, etc. Do not put riders in the same group as non-riders -- put similar groups together -- those who commute on bus vs. those who use for recreation -- create discussion guides and use moderator techniques and be sure to listen, record everything for later transcription. Video and audio ideal. 2) Quantitative -- design survey for the public using qualitative findings and agency needs. do not release online to just anyone --- control who gets survey and who responds -- by random, rep design. this needs to go to riders and non-riders, who are in all incomes -- rep of the consumer population that is RMTD's potential customer -- Done right you get quantifiable, statistically valid and actionable data. This is how RMTD will really understand what is needed. Please don't use this survey as anything more than a tool to develop a proper qualitative discussion guide for focus groups and a random, rep quantitative survey.

Thanks for doing a great job on the new downtown hub, keep security up and riders will continue to flock there

Just maybe make day and evening services longer to help persons get to and from work or able to get places needed for groceries or other necessities.

Ever since Belvidere lost their Kmart store there isn't a bus stop on the south side of us-20. It get dangerous crossing the highway to get to the bus.

Want the downtown station done and open.

My son, (8 years old), never rides the bus without being in his wheelchair. Yet there is not a disabled pass to cover his rides. We use your service to get to all of his medical appointments and every shopping trip we make. When on a fixed income that costs quite a bit. How about a child's disability ID and/or half fare companion rate? When it takes all day to make the round to appointment and back home. Then do that 3 or 4 times

a week, running up to \$13 a day. A fixed income is gone. You choose between getting to that appointment or paying a necessary utility. You cover adults with disabilities but what about the families with disabled children?

At times on the east state route the bus is overcrowded. They should have two buses running at the busy times of the day.

Safer bus stops. Higher security

Increase ridership among college students and major healthcare systems. Create a U-Loop that connects RVC, RU, UIC, public library, etc.

I do not have other transportations that why I used the RMTD

Saturday night and more Sunday

The system with transfers after you pay should change. I end up paying \$10 or more

Rockford need longer hours and weekend bus routes.

Most important to me is to get a phone app to see where buses are to reduce outdoor waiting times in the cold and rainy weather.

It takes way too long to take a bus here. It wastes your entire day and I have to sit at school for six hours just because it takes so long to get home. I have to walk for miles on end and with taxis getting cheaper you need to do something.

Instead of doing loop style maybe more of a grid style

Make it timely, make it convenient, show the public features and benefits, offer day passes for people who want to go from one attraction to the next on the weekend, on their day off, or during their visit to Rockford, offer a summer bus route that connects the main attractions to hotels and points of entry for out of town transit services. Transit service should be available to the work force for all shifts every day of the week. People should also be able to access the grocery store, friends and relatives, immediate care, entertainment, parades, fireworks, festivals, etc... even if these events are on a holiday or on a weekend after 5:00 PM

To me, the main focus should be increasing routes, and frequency of stops. It is not convenient at all when I have to walk 1 1/2 miles to the nearest bus stop.

Upgrade the buses and PLEASE have them cleaned thoroughly weekly.

Enhancing the bus line helps people work in the evening, weekends, and surrounding cities.

Drivers need to have more security. Bulletproof glass is as essential in Rockford as it is in Chicago. There is a real increasing sense that it is becoming potentially dangerous to ride the busses in Rockford.

My doctor is on Riverside and Perryville, would be nice to catch a bus to shopping, like Riverside, Harlem, or West Lane, to doctors

Change bus stop back to Pierpont and Preston

Rockford should think outside the box and really make their city walker, biker friendly. This can be done by incentivizing using the bus more often

No thank you

The bus system to and from Belvidere does not have hours that would provide individuals to get to and from work. The hours are too short.

I would love to see a train service that connects Rockford to Chicago and a train service that connects Rockford to Milwaukee. Trains can serve two purposes, they can bring people in to work in the Rockford region, and/or allow for people to get more access to jobs. Rockford has expanded to be a medical and engineering hub, and a train service can bring people to work in these industries. Furthermore, a train service can allow people to find jobs outside Rockford, in the suburbs or Chicago area. This can greatly decrease unemployment in Rockford, and it help the economy by bringing in people with money to spend in Rockford. I've met many people who drive every day from Chicago to Rockford to work, as well as people who drive to Chicago to work. They tell me the commute is awful, and many times it is unreliable with the traffic. A train service can bring relatable cheap transportation. All major cities and suburbs have train services, and its time Rockford gets one too.

Do not allow unsafe passengers to travel on busses. Run busses later into the evening. Hire friendlier drivers, almost every driver I have ever had has been rude and disrespectful.

If the pickup time on the web site says 25 after, then the buses should wait until said time to depart. I've missed a few buses because it came early. I have to wait in whatever type of weather if they're running late.

Have buses go from Rockford to Beloit

I ride the bus numerous times a day and there are a few drivers that can be rude and seem to have power trip issues. Also I ride the E. State bus every morning, Monday through Saturday, and the E State bus (the 6:15am bus) is almost always the last bus to show up at the downtown transfer center. The only time I really feel there is an issue with this is when it's extremely cold outside. If this could be addressed, myself along with many other bus riders would really appreciate this.
