U.S. Census Bureau Makes Operational Adjustments Due to COVID-19 Local Response Rates Higher Compared to National Average

ROCKFORD, IL – The 2020 Census in now underway and households across America, including here locally, are responding every day. Due to COVID-19, the U.S. Census Bureau is adapting and delaying some of their operations to protect the health of their staff and the public, and to ensure a complete and accurate population count.

2020 Census Timeline Adjustment Highlights

"We are also adjusting our Census outreach operations locally," said Wester Wuori, City of Rockford Chief of Staff and Chair of the Regional Complete Count Committee. "We will continue to monitor the situation and make additional changes as needed. Our ultimate goal, is to have everyone in the Rockford region complete their survey either online, by phone, or by mail. We are excited to see that local response-rates are higher than the national average. We still have work to do, but we are moving the dial in the right direction."

The region is currently outpacing the national average response rate. This may be attributed, in part, to a coordinated effort by the <u>Regional Complete Count Committee</u> and other civically engaged organizations, to increase awareness about the Census and motivate residents to respond.
