Illinois Governor J. B. Pritzker and R1 Planning Council Host 2020 Census News Conference: Share Recent Grant Successes and New Initiatives

ROCKFORD, IL – On Thursday, July 16, Governor J.B. Pritzker joined the Region 1 Planning Council (RPC) to host a News Conference at the Rockford City Market's outdoor pavilion to share the region's recent Census 2020 outreach successes and to announce a new wave of 2020 Census grant funding coming to northern Illinois.



Last fall, the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) named RPC as the

Northern Region Regional Intermediary for the Illinois Census Office's 2020 Census Grant Program. As a result,
the Council received \$1,015,015.00 in phase I and II funding to reinvest in Northern Illinois to encourage a
complete and accurate 2020 Census count. RPC accepted applications and 14 sub grants were awarded to assist
in reaching historically- undercounted populations located throughout our five-county region of Winnebago,
Boone, Ogle, Stephenson, and DeKalb counties.

"Over the past eight months, grant sub recipients coordinated hundreds of outreach events, distributed thousands of marketing materials, and implemented social media, billboard, radio, television, and digital marketing campaigns. As a result, our region's survey response rates have exceeded state and national averages, which has been a direct correlation to all the work accomplished through these grant efforts," said Ivy Hood, 2020 Census Grant Program Manager.

Phase III 2020 Census Grant Dollars Awarded to RPC

Recently, it was announced that RPC will receive \$432,941.00 in additional phase III grant funding to continue 2020 Census outreach efforts to increase survey results in the Northern Illinois region. Much of the funding will be redistributed to sub-awardees to assist with 2020 Census outreach efforts. This new Fiscal Year 2021 phase of the grant program will run from July 1 through October 31, 2020, to line up with the U.S. Census Bureau's operational timeline extension.

"In receiving this phase II funding, we are grateful for the State of Illinois and Governor Pritzker's commitment to the Northern Illinois region. These dollars will go directly into communities located in our five-county area, helping to ensure a complete and accurate Census count so that each town, village, city, and county will receive their share of federal funding and representation," said Michael Dunn, Executive Director of the Region 1 Planning Council.

Responses from completed U.S. Census surveys is used to determine how billions of dollars in federal funding are allocated locally. The Census results are also used to determine the number of seats each state has in the U.S. House of Representatives.
