OLD BUSINESS

a) Contours

Sarah reported that she has been recreating the Contours with a DEM that has been smoothed 15 times. While there are no jagged lines performance is, though better, still a little slow. A z value has also been added. A copy of the contours has been sent to Esri to see if they could help determine why the performance is so slow. A last resort would be to tile the Contours.

b) Aerial Photography

The new images have been placed on the web sites(s) and are the default photography. Like in the past, the 2018 images have been added to the archive. Scott Sanders inquired as to whether or not the transparency of the aerials could be adjusted like is available for the layers. Mr. Gregg replied that he could look into adding a transparency slider for the base maps as well. There is some concern that the images are a little darker than the 2018 imagery. Mr. Gregg indicated that we will look into some in house options to adjust the contrast, and will also reach out to Kucera to look for some assistance/advice.

c) New Public Site Preview/Feedback

Mr. Gregg reported that the new site will be available for preview/review on WinGIS' old public facing server. The internal address is <u>http://ags.wingis.org</u> while the address for anyone not on the network is <u>http://map.wingis.org</u>. Members and Subscription members will be notified and will be given the chance to use the site, as well as provide feedback, for several weeks prior to the new site's go live date. (which is tbd).

NEW BUSINESS

a) Census Data

Sarah Stromberg add the geometry for the census layers to the census database. At this point there are not tables to join to them, where one can join income or population to block groups. If one needs that information before we make it available a good resource is Ersi's Living Atlas, a layer you can pull into your map as a service.

Mr. Gregg indicates that Cherry Valley has selected a new Tech member to represent that at future meetings named Steve Strasser.
