Winnebago County Trustee Property Sale is Live!

ROCKFORD, IL - Continuously working to revitalize neighborhoods and communities in the region, R1 Planning Council, as the appointed agent of the Winnebago County Trustee Program, has gone live with the sale of over 500 Trustee owned properties.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM: Properties for sale through the Winnebago County Trustee Program are acquired through a tax delinquency process. These properties were at least three years delinquent on taxes, with no tax buyer purchasing the tax certificate. State statute prescribes that these properties become owned by the Winnebago County Trustee on behalf of all taxing bodies. The Winnebago County Board has appointed Region 1 Planning Council as Agent to the Winnebago County Trustee to market and sell the properties. The goal of R1 as Agent is to get properties back into taxpaying status by offering them to the public through an online sales system.

HOW TO BUY: The Winnebago County Trustee sale is conducted through an online system. There is no charge to view, register, or bid on properties. The sale has started and will end Tuesday, February 15th at 3pm.
