ROCKFORD, IL – Today, the Rockford Chamber of Commerce announces its full list of winners for the *2022 40 Leaders Under 40 Awards* recognizing the best and brightest young professionals working in the Rockford region. **Jason Holcomb, Director of Community Impact at Region 1 Planning Council was among the 40 leaders awarded**. "It's a special honor to have been nominated by my wonderful colleagues at R1 Planning and to have been selected alongside community leaders who I've worked with on numerous projects to advance the health of our community" said Holcomb.

Holcomb, who joined Region 1 in 2020, is Director of Community Impact and responsible for day-to-day operations of the Winnebago County Mental Health Board, allocating funding from the 1/2 cent sales tax for mental health in Winnebago County. Outside of work, Holcomb volunteers his time on the board of Sustain Rockford and as a trainer with the Northern Illinois Center for Non-Profit Excellence.
