1) Call to Order

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Mayor Jury at 7:32 am.

2) Roll Call

4) Consent Agenda

a) Approval of Meeting Minutes: January 27, 2023

b) Resolution Approving an Intergovernmental Agreement with Winnebago County Rail Authority
Mr. Dunn discussed the need to make a recommendation to the full RPC governing board for their May 2023
meeting to authorize the Executive Director to enter into an Intergovernmental agreement with Winnebago
County Rail Authority to have Region 1 Planning Council Operate and administer the development authority, reporting to the rail authority board.

Motion **<u>approved</u>** unanimously by voice vote.

5) Executive Director Report

Mr. Dunn discussed the upcoming opportunity for land bank funding in Springfield, and the need to operate the land bank as a development authority for commercial and industrial opportunities, in addition to its track of record success on residential development. Mr. Dunn provided the board updates on staff positions coming to the planning council, including investing in the Economic Development District to bring online more technical support for its members related to asset inventory, utility data, and site readiness. Mr. Dunn discussed an updated o the MPO's new Livable Community Initiative (LCI) with the goal to launch in summer 2023 with its external partners committed.

The Executive Committee provided guidance to keep moving forward on all initiatives and asked for a special meeting to further discuss the Economic Development District for mid-April.
