7. Guest Speakers: Ana Diaz-Puskar and Rachel McLaughlin from Forefront Power

Ms. Diaz-Puskar, Senior Associate of Sales, and Ms. McLaughlin, Senior Vice President of Sales and Marketing at Forefront Power, gave a presentation to the Board on a money-saving solar project that Forefront is coordinating for Rockford Public Schools. Diaz-Puskar and McLaughlin explained that Forefront can design and build similar rooftop or ground-mounted solar array projects for R1 local government partners. ForeFront Power is a San Francisco based company that is a leading developer of commercial and industrial-scale solar energy and battery storage projects in the U.S. and Mexico.

a. R1 Activities Update: Sydney Turner, Director of Regional Planning, presented an update on R1 projects since the last board meeting. Current priorities are updating federal planning documents (CEDS, MTP, CAP), 2024 Infrastructure Priorities Report, Health & Transportation Study, Bus Rapid Transit Feasibility Study, watershed outreach demonstration project, and a community energy needs assessment.
