# 1) Call to Order, Roll Call, and Representation

With a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Mayor Jury, City of Loves Park, at 8:31 am.

## 5) SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT – FY 2021 CALL FOR PROJECTS

Ms. Turner provided a brief update regarding the STBG Call for Projects. The Call for Projects closed at 5 PM on Monday, February 22, 2021. The MPO did not receive applications for new projects, however, it did receive several project updates, including updates from Winnebago County, City of Rockford, City of Belvidere, and Boone County. For next steps, the MPO staff will review the updated applications as well as the previously submitted projects to determine if additional information is needed from partner agencies. From that point, each of the submitted projects will be run through the selection criteria and a ranking of projects will be developed. A draft program of projects will be presented at the April Technical and Policy Committees to award these funds; the MPO has approximately \$9,680,305 dollars to award to regionally significant projects.

Discussion was held by the committee on the levels of funding, project submittals, and programming of the funds.

# 6) COUNTY-WIDE PUBLIC TRANSIT SERVICE

Mr. Dunn introduced a discussion led by Mr. Stubbe on the expansion of transit services outside of RMTD's traditional service area. There is a need to serve the underserved parts of Winnebago County with rural transportation. The rural providers are eligible for federal funding, plus local/state reimbursement. However, technical support including equipment and staff would be necessary.

### 7) OTHER BUSINESS

Ms. Turner provided a brief report on the following administrative modifications that were made to the FY2021 – FY2024 Transportation Improvement Program:

- o Projects or a portion of these projects have been authorized for Advanced Construction:
  - #1-20-10: ILL 70, Pecatonica River to 0.1 mi W of Safford Rd in Rockford
  - #1-21-4: Districtwide (Bridges) SN 101-0123, 101-6133, 101-0195/96, SN 101-0197/98
  - #1-21-5: Districtwide (Bridges) SN 004-0013 US BUS 20 over Kishwaukee River on E edge of Belvidere
- o Projects or a portion of these projects have been converted from Advanced Construction to current status:
  - #1-17-7: I-39, US 20, & Harrison Ave I-39: 0.8 miles N of Blackhawk Rd to I-90; US 20: I-39 to 0.3 miles E of Kishwaukee River; Harrison Ave: Bell School Rd to 1-39



Ms. Turner also provided a brief report on the Electric Vehicle Readiness Plan. On January 25<sup>th</sup>, the MPO released it for a 30-day public comment period. The comments can be sent directly to Ms. Turner and are due March 1<sup>st</sup>. Some comments have already been received and have been minor technical adjustments. Discussion was held by the committee on potential grant opportunities, local preparation and readiness, and partnerships with national vendors such as iFiber. Requests to research a business model that could generate revenue for local municipalities, and Illinois laws prohibiting the resell of electricity were made.

### 8) ADJOURNMENT
