MPO RESOLUTION 2023-05

RE:	Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Act of 1962, as amended, and the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provide for an urban transportation planning process; and
WHEREAS	the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) currently authorizes funding to improve our nation's transportation system for highways, highway safety, public transit, alternative non-motorized forms of transportation, and freight; and
WHEREAS	the IIJA Act and its predecessors, require a Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) as well as a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and
WHEREAS	the Region 1 Planning Council is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Rockford Urban and Metropolitan Area, and the MPO Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process: and
WHEREAS	the MPO Policy Committee has adopted the June 23, 2022 version of the Fiscal Year 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and;
WHEREAS	the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have approved the FY 2023-2026 MPO TIP; and
WHEREAS	Illinois Department of Transportation requested an updated the cost breakout for a project phase; Winnebago County Highway Department requested an updated cost breakout; City of Belvidere requested update the cost breakouts and inclusion of additional project phases; Rockford Mass Transit District included a new project.
WHEREAS	the projects being amended in the adopted and approved version of the FY 2023-2026 TIP will not affect or impact the other projects listed in the FY 2023-2026 MPO TIP; and
WHEREAS	the MPO Technical Committee has recommended the adoption of the TIP amendment by the MPO Policy Committee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The MPO Policy Committee hereby amends the FY 2023-2026 MPO Transportation Improvement Program to include the projects listed in "Attachment A".
