PRESENTATIONS & PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

OLD BUSINESS

- GIS Tech Position:
 - Mr. Gregg introduced Mr. Aaron Frey who started as WinGIS Tech on Monday, June 18, 2018.
- NINGA Update/NINGA SME User Group:
 - Mr. Gregg stated that Ms. Stromberg has had conversations with NINGA SME User Group and accessed that the data clean-up process will not be as cumbersome as previously anticipated.
- Portal Integration
 - Mr. Gregg handed out the Portal Integration Update/Conversion schedule and provided a brief summary. The process is anticipated to be completed by November-2018.
- Database Upgrade
 - Mr. Gregg stated that Ms. Stromberg has been working with members to finish the database upgrade and is within days of getting everyone on the 10.2.2 Arc Desktop version.

NEW BUSINESS

- FY19 Budget
 - Mr. Gregg stated that WinGIS is moving forward to start their budget to start on July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019 (FY2019) to coordinate with Region 1 Planning Council (R1PC) fiscal year. The IMRF employer status has been delayed and is anticipated to start in September-2018. Mr. Gregg provided the following changes to the WinGIS budget going forward:
 - > No car pool line item, this is replaced with a travel expense line item.
 - > Postage and Parking expenses are new line items.
 - DoIT (Winnebago County IT) line item charges has increased approximately \$12K but this amount has not been finalized.
 - Legal services line item has been added. WinGIS will no longer be using the Winnebago County State's Attorney's office for legal assistance.
 - ESRI Conference expenses will be expended in the upcoming FY19 budget due to the budget schedule change.
 - Carryover amount of approximately \$100K but this amount still needs to be clarified with Winnebago County.

Mr. Gregg stated that the aerials are being processed and WinGIS anticipates receiving the aerials by August-2018.
